From the Interim Pastor

Jesus loves me this I know for the bible tells me so little ones to him belong they are weak but he is strong.

Yes Jesus loves me Yes Jesus loves me Yes Jesus loves me the bible tells me so.

The message is so simple yet so important. Making the rounds in the news is a story of a 17 year old living in Massachusetts who was an over achiever and a very remarkable young woman. Because of her effort, she had earned her place in whatever field she chose. She loved robotics and hoped to attend MIT.

She was always positive, appreciative and upbeat. She also had a secret diary over the last two years that showed a completely different person on the inside. No matter what she did, it wasn't enough and that meant that she was a failure.

One night she left the house and never returned. She threw herself off the bridge on an overpass and died. She wasn't hit by the traffic because she was on the side of the Interstate and yet no one even saw her body lying there.

None of her friends or family saw this coming and they were completely shocked. They had no idea how darkly she saw herself because she never showed this to anyone. After her death they found her diary and then they grieved all the more. What she believed about herself simply wasn't true.

Because of this tragedy now her parents speak to others about their daughter. They know there are others out there who show something completely different on the outside from how they really see themselves on the inside and they know how dangerous this is. This young woman was loved by her family and her friends but she didn't know how to love herself.

The desire for people of all ages to be perfect today can only push us into despair and with this kind of pressure there is no room for love. Love may be all around us but it is difficult to penetrate an empty heart because we also need to learn how to love ourselves – just as we are.

I too, struggled with this growing up and I know these young people really hurt inside and we can't always tell who is hurting. There is no magic cure – only a slow realization that how they see themselves on the inside is not always real. No matter how confident someone looks, we need to keep telling them how much we care about them so that they can learn how to care about themselves. And we tell them we care not because of what they do, but simply because of who they are. We do this again and again and again.
