From the Interim pastor.....

*Our Council President talked with the congregation before church on May 12th about an interview with Carol Pretorius. She is a candidate for a program within the Lutheran Church called TEEM which puts her on a path for ordination. Carol met with both the church council and the call committee on Wednesday May 8th at 7pm at St. Peter Lutheran Church. The interview was very favorable for everyone. Because of this the church council now wants the entire congregation to meet Carol after the worship service on **June 9th**. If this goes well, then the council will meet to approve Carol to become a pastor at St. Peter as she continues her path for ordination. The congregation would then also be asked to vote as well on **Sunday June 23rd**.*

To introduce Carol here are some words written by Carol to describe herself.....

“I am excited about the possibility of coming to serve the people of St. Peter Evangelical Lutheran Church. I have a deep love of people and a deep love of God. As an educator, counselor and pastor’s wife, I have had many opportunities to develop skills for ministry. As an educator, I have been a middle school language arts teacher, a first grade teacher, a Title I teacher, a literacy coordinator, and an elementary principal. In 2013, I retired from education to pursue a clinical counseling degree. My interest was to gain skills to help people heal from emotional wounds and trauma. My greatest love in counseling is working with people of faith to help them meet Jesus in deeper ways on their healing journey. While attending Ashland Seminary, I earned a special certification to do Formational Prayer with people. I earned my master’s in counseling in 2016 and I am a licensed professional counselor. My career path changed when my husband Doug and I moved to Wapakoneta in September so Doug could be the pastor of St. Mark Evangelical Lutheran Church. Since then, I have been using the time to settle into our new home, connect with new people, and to discern a call to enter ministry as a pastoral candidate through the TEEM program (Theological Education for Emerging Ministry).

Doug and I have been married for 40 years as of this June 23rd. I taught 6th grade while Doug attended seminary at Trinity in Columbus, and we had our only child, Andrew, while Doug was on internship in Stow, Ohio. Upon leaving Seminary, we moved to Bellville, Ohio where Doug was the Pastor at St. Paul Lutheran Church for 35 years. Through those years, Doug and I supported each other in the raising of Andrew and in allowing each other to continue to grow in faith and skills to live lives out of being faithful to God in our vocations. It was during the call process for Doug during this last year that I began feeling a call to ministry. The possibility was affirmed to me while attending the Bishop’s Hour here in the social room at St. Peter’s last October.

As an extrovert, I love to spend time with people. Through the years I have had opportunities to preach, sing in the choir and praise team, facilitate an adult Sunday school class, and lead healing care groups. I have creative interests in working in my flower beds, singing and painting. One of my greatest passions though, is to pray with people and help them to make deeper connections to God in faith practices.”

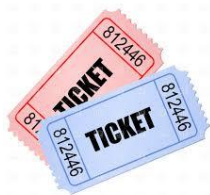

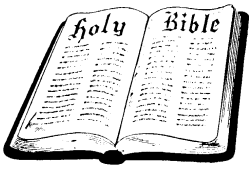

DELPHOS COMMUNITY VBS VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES



The following is a brief description of volunteer opportunities for Vacation Bible School. Contact Carrie Calvelage at 419-233-4561(text or phone call) if you can help in **ANY** way.

DECORATING COMMITTEE—Help design, create and set up the decorations prior to the start of the event. This Committee is being chaired by our very own Terry Nelson (thanks so much Terry!).

TEAR DOWN COMMITTEE—Help take down the decorations and put away the materials the evening of July 11 after the program is over.

CREW LEADER/Assistant Crew Leader - You are the light and love of Christ as you lead a small group of elementary age children (preschool through Grade 5) to their various activities. You provide encouragement, direction and guidance helping your crew with the various activities. This position can be held by youth grades 6 and up.

BIBLE TEACHER – This is a great opportunity to engage the students in the daily lesson. Some materials are provided; leader book is provided.
