#### "A Little Bit of This and That"

I am very excited to answer the call to enter the ministry and serve you as I return to school to become an ordained pastor. This process is taking place under a program called TEEM (Theological Education for Emerging Ministry). This is a three year program that leads to a certification toward ordination, unlike the traditional route in which one earns a Master's of Divinity.

During the next three years, I will take two classes on line during each semester. I will also be part of a learning cohort that meets for one week each semester at the synod office in Indiana for intensive studies with our professors from Pacific Lutheran Seminary. I have learned as a pastor's wife that visiting people in their home helps to build stronger relationships. It is an important way for me to hear your stories and learn about your interests. The meetings will also help you to get to know me. Therefore, I would like to begin visiting those of you who are open to having me come during these next several months. I will set aside some afternoons and evenings to meet with you and will probably have a sign- up sheet in the office to make this process easier. Also, if there are special school events that you would like me to come to, please let me know and I will try to come.

On July 28, Pastor Steve will be on vacation so my husband, Pastor Doug, will preside at communion and I will preach. I hope you can attend so you can meet Doug.


