#### A Little Bit of This and That...

As I write this, we have not yet celebrated Christmas and I am like you trying to get prepared. Just this morning I finished putting the ornaments on the tree. The goal will be to connect with each other and support each other on our journeys of growing deeper in faith while praying for others, the town, the church, and ourselves as we try different prayer practices. This is open to men and women and you can even bring a friend. Please let me know if you are interested in becoming a part of this group. Our first meeting will be January 13.

Also, Shelby Koenig and I are excited to announce that we are planning to revive a **High School Youth Group** for students in grades 9-12. We plan to meet for about 1½ in the afternoons of the third Sunday of each month. We will meet January 19<sup>th</sup> from 2:30-4:00 and plan to do some organizing as well as to play some games. Students are encouraged to bring their favorite board game or card game. High school students may also invite friends to join in. We have some fun ideas for activities in the future, and also want to incorporate some ministry opportunities to help others as well as to have some activities that deepen faith and help to cope with the stress of being teenagers in this busy time of
