A Little Bit of This and That...

February seems to be flying by and when you receive this we will already be into the season of Lent. There was time when I used to really dislike this season as the focus is often on being more solemn. I am naturally a more joyful person so thinking that I had to be more solemn was hard and not a very helpful way to enter into the season of Lent. I have come to realize over the years that the season of Lent is not really so much about being so solemn as it provides an opportunity to focus more deeply on our relationship with Jesus and that is something that I dearly love.

Many people like to give things up for the 40 days of Lent, but I have never been a person who has done well with that. Instead, I think it might be more important to focus on adding something to our spiritual practice. For me, this is easier and, in some ways, harder. If you have struggles with finding time to pray, you might consider setting your alarm to get up 10 minutes earlier and then find a quiet place to pray for 10 minutes or so. Maybe, choosing to read several good Christian books that help you grow could be a good practice to try. Maybe picking up a devotional or reading a chapter a day in your Bible might be beneficial. Or, keeping a gratitude journal might be appealing. One thing that I would encourage each of us to do, especially if this has not been your Lenten practice, is to consider taking the time to attend the Lenten Soup suppers and the service to follow. This year we will have soup suppers in the parish hall at 6:15 PM and then the Lenten services in the sanctuary will start at 7:00PM. The services will follow a similar format each week. We will start with a hymn and the reading of a psalm together. Then one of the members of the church will be talking a little bit about their faith journey. This is an important time of sharing as we need to begin to share our faith stories with each other. (Don't worry, I have asked people already to share, so no one will be put on the spot.) After the sharing we will do a short reflective prayer exercise in which we listen to a scripture three (3) times and listen for what God is speaking to us. We will then close with prayer and a hymn. Please consider making this a part of your Lenten worship. I have been doing a lot of studying in scripture about how one's heart plays a role in helping us to draw near to God and to see and hear how God is moving in our lives and those of others. When our hearts become complacent or hard, we stop listening and ultimately, we lose out on experiencing the peace and presence of God at work in our lives. I want my heart to provide good soil for God to be at work. I think that is really what most of us wants. Lent is a good time to cultivate the ground of our hearts to be open to the journey of faith with Jesus. May the grace and peace of our Lord richly bless you as you journey into this season of Lent.
