#### A Little Bit of This and That for July 2021

As I write this today, Doug and I have just arrived at Mother Pretorius' bedside and she is dying. Four weeks ago, she was vibrant and full of life, but now I listen to her breathing and pray for God to be merciful and call her home to him.

During this time, I have been pondering on the relationship journey my mother-in-law has had with God. She has walked closely with God and cherished not only her early morning study and prayer times, but also her 6:00AM prayer group that she met with each morning for over 25 years. Marycarol found joy in her relationship with God and loved to share her knowledge in a monthly newsletter that she sent out to family and friends. Life has not been easy for her as she became a widow in her early thirties and was left to raise six children. She experienced not only the loss of her husband, but the murder of her thirteen-year-old daughter and then later in the death of her 43-year-old son. In each of these times she has clung to her faith and God has been gracious to her.

Through the years in my 42 year marriage to her oldest son, she has modeled faith and been a source of love and joy. She spoke deeply of God's love for us and sought to follow Jesus. Now as I listen to her breathing, I am ready to let her go into the loving arms of our savior. The cycle of life will bring new life to her. Yes, we will mourn and miss her, but she will move into the next phase of life to be reunited with those who have gone on before her. In faith, she has placed her trust in Jesus and it is this faith that allows each of us to place our trust in God and the hope of the resurrection. She has a future that awaits and so I can rejoice for her. She will journey on.

This week I heard one of my classmates say that her mentor pastor told her that the most important job for parents is to raise their children to know that they are loved by God and to help their children to understand that their relationship with God is the most important basis for their life. This is a huge responsibility for parents and the church.

So, it is on July 11, that Corey and Ashley Kloeppel will bring their son Jack to be baptized. This baptism is a time for rejoicing, for in this holy sacrament of baptism God will reach down to Jack to claim him as his beloved child and to fill him with Jesus and the Holy Spirit. Jack's journey of faith will begin with this cleansing and claiming work of God in our midst. As a congregation we will welcome Jack as a brother in Christ and a co-worker with us in the kingdom. We will support Corey and Ashley as they raise Jack in the faith and we will trust that the Holy Spirit will call Jack into a deep relationship and awareness of God in his life as he grows and matures. This is exciting as this new little person embarks on a journey of faith.

It is important for all of us to remember that we are a confessing church. We recognize that we cannot journey through our lives without sinning and we need confession and forgiveness on a regular basis. We also need the forgiveness and filling of Jesus that comes with communion. We

come to church with hearts and hands open to receive the Word and the sacrament of communion. We gather to worship together, to grow in faith and to support each other as we journey forward. This is a gift. I am so thankful to share this journey of faith with you.

As I say goodbye to my mother-in-law who has journeyed in a life of faith and love with our Lord, I pray for Jack and all of our children that they might truly grow to know how much they are loved and cherished by our Lord. May we rejoice in the fellowship of all believers and may we too, gain a glimpse of the deep love that our Lord has for each of us.
