A Little Bit of This and That for March...

Do you have important stories of your family that are important to you? At the Rostered Ministers' Retreat this year, the speaker, Dr. Kelly Sherman- Conroy who focused on the importance of telling our stories as well as the stories of our ancestors.

If you were to share your story, where would you start? What has shaped you? How has your faith journey impacted your life? Was there someone in your family who impacted your faith? Was there a person in the church? What events in your life have brought your pain or joy? What is important for you to share with your children or grandchildren?

Enclosed in this newsletter is a handout I received from the speaker, Dr. Kelly Sherman-Conroy, and I invite you to take a look at it and consider sitting with it and pondering what you would write about your journey. What would you feel is important to share? I would add a faith box because as Christians, we are called into a journey of faith. I am so thankful for the work of God in my life. I do not know where I would be today without the deep roots that I have developed due to the work of Jesus and the Holy Spirit in my life and in the lives of you and others God has placed in my life.

During this Lenten season, we are studying the Psalms on Wednesday evenings. One of the concepts that we are using is the idea that events in our lives can orient us to God or disorient us away from God. There is always an opportunity to re-orient our lives in faith back to God. Orientation, disorientation, and reorientation represent the various aspects of our individual faith journeys. Using these three lenses could be an interesting way to view your life as well. What experiences have deepened your movement of faith toward God and what events have pulled you away? How has God called you back to deeper involvement in your faith journey? I am always amazed at the deep love of God at work in our midst to love us even when we sometimes cannot love ourselves. God is good and for this I am so grateful.
