We are tentatively planning a potluck on **April 28** to take place after church. We are hoping to have meat provided and to have us all bring other dishes to fill out the meal.

Paint and Praise will take place on **April 17**, starting at 6:00pm. The sign-up sheet is located on the parish hall bulletin board. The cost is \$15. Come and enjoy a fun evening of fellowship.

IROR is going to do matching funds up to \$500.00 to raise money so we can reach out to help a family or several families (depending on how much money is given) in their recovery process from the recent tornado. Many of the families effected do not have extra funds to even pay for their needed insurance deductibles and/or cover other unexpected needs. Over the month of April, you may designate a special offering to go to helping the survivors who lost everything in the tornado and IROR will work with Terry Nelson to see that the funds go to families who have the greatest need. (Terry is the art teacher at the elementary school in Indian Lake. She told Pastor Carol that 190 of their students are now homeless.)

Maintenance:

The weathering of the front doors and the need to have electronic door opening for handicap accessibility has become a concern to be addressed. Also, our sign out front is a concern. The council and maintenance team are just in the gathering of information about fixing the issues.
